MAYORAL DIRECTIVE NO. 2021–02 ANCHORAGE ECONOMIC RECOVERY AND DIVERSIFICATION

WHEREAS, the Anchorage economy has languished over the past few years, exasperated by a lack of diversification and most recently impacted by COVID-19 pandemic restrictions; and

WHEREAS, The Anchorage economy has been primarily supported by the oil and gas industry and government services; and

WHEREAS, Extensive government regulations and a lack of innovative economic incentives has created a business development climate that is not competitive with other west coast metropolitan areas; and

WHEREAS, Anchorage is the largest city in Alaska and the primary business hub for economic activity statewide; and

WHEREAS, Anchorage has a distinct geographical advantage to develop and expand both existing and new businesses; and

WHEREAS, Anchorage has an intermodal transportation system that includes a vibrant international airport, major marine port, railroad, and road system; and

WHEREAS, Joint Base Elmendorf Richardson (JBER) is located in Anchorage and provides a tremendous economic benefit to the municipality; and

WHEREAS, The University of Alaska, Anchorage is an integral part of the municipalities ability to train a diversified workforce; and

WHEREAS, Anchorage is the center for medical services, which includes a sophisticated UMed District that integrates hospital, clinic, medical support services, and the University of Alaska, Anchorage; and

WHEREAS, Anchorage is Alaska's financial center, with numerous financial institutions that support the economy of both Anchorage and the state; and

WHEREAS, Anchorage hosts the headquarter operations for most Alaska Native Corporations; and

WHEREAS, Anchorage has experienced an increase in tourism, with projections that tourism could increase substantially with infrastructure and venue improvements; and

 WHEREAS, Anchorage has a number of organizations focused on economic development, diversification, and business expansion; such as the Anchorage Economic Development Corporation, the Anchorage Community Development Authority, the Anchorage Chamber of Commerce, and others; and

WHEREAS, If Anchorage is to remain competitive with other major metropolitan areas and have a vibrant economy, aggressive action must be immediately initiated to identify business development opportunities, municipal policies and incentive programs, funding availabilities, and needs of the local business community to expand and proser.

THEREFORE, THE MAYOR OF ANCHORAGE HEREBY RESOLVES:

The Municipality of Anchorage shall aggressively pursue economic revitalization, expansion, and diversification.

As such, an *Anchorage Economic Revitalization and Diversification Advisory Committee* (AERDAC) is hereby established to develop a blueprint to achieve a vibrant local economy.

The AERDAC shall be Chaired by the Executive Director of the Anchorage Community Development Authority and report as an independent organization directly to the Mayor.

The AERDAC may hire a facilitator to organize, manage, and execute the objectives of this directive.

The AERDAC shall use the 2021 **Economic Recovery Transition Team** report as the framework for their work.

The AERDAC shall provide the Mayor with status reports 100 days after activation and every four months thereafter.

Membership on the AERDAC shall be selected by the Mayor, within 30 days of the signing of this directive.

Meetings of the AERDAC shall be noticed and conducted in accordance with the Alaska Open Meetings requirements.
